

## **Board of Directors Meeting July 10, 2007**

Minutes – The minutes from the June meeting were reviewed. It was noted that the shooting seminar funded for juniors was \$400. A motion was made by Dugre and 2<sup>nd</sup> by VanNoie to accept the minutes as typed. The motion was carried.

Financial Report – The financial report was read and reviewed. A motion was made by J. Baugnet and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Landwehr. The motion was carried.

### **Committee Reports:**

Trap – The summer leagues are going well. We have lots of targets and the third trap machine has been repaired.

Archery – The 3D league is averaging 35 shooters per week. A four-week broadhead shoot will be held this fall when the summer leagues end.

Rifle – No representation

Juniors – This summer the shooters are in Kentucky for the air rifle nationals, at a match in Rapid City, South Dakota and traveling to a shooting camp in Minnesota. There was an article in Shooting Sports sponsored by the NRA highlighting the De Pere juniors. The fall league will begin in September. They have raised almost \$600 at a rummage sale and sold their brass for a total of nearly \$1,000. In addition, they made \$247 selling food at the 4H match. They need \$2,200 to purchase an video aiming device. They have found a member to match their fundraising, so they should be very close to their goal!

Pistol – Not doing much this summer. The compressor and target timer control will be checked prior to the start of the fall season.

4H – The Brown County Invitational shoot was held at De Pere on July 7<sup>th</sup>. There were 59 shooters present from 13 different counties shooting 187 events. Many compliments were received from around the state.

Building & Grounds – The bar flooded last month and RotoRooter was called. It appears that the trap under the bar is rotted through. The lights that are not working in the garage will be investigated.

### **Old Business:**

The first annual 26-gun raffle is scheduled to coincide with the WI pick-3 numbers. The committee will renew the gun list this week. The tickets will be printed as soon as possible. Lots of 100 tickets will be given to members to hand out in groups of 10 for others to sell. It will be the member's responsibility to keep track of who has the tickets and collect the money.

Members are encouraged to pay attention to the OSHA attempt to restrict ammunition sales through the restriction of gun powder.
